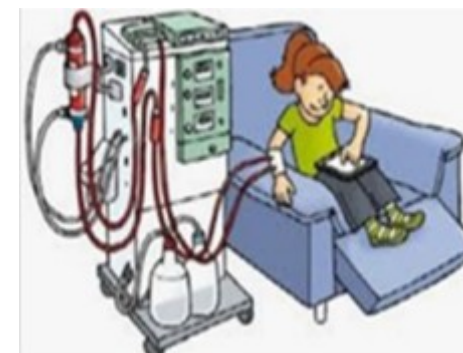

The aim of our programme is to empower patients to manage their own haemodialysis treatments,

To allow you, the patient to have more freedom to do dialysis at a time that suits you in the comfort of your own home.

Comprehensive training is provided.

Once you are fully trained and feel confident, you will be able to carry out your dialysis treatments at home whilst being supported by home dialysis nurses.

Spend more time doing what you love

If you currently dialyse in a hospital, home dialysis could potentially be an option for you.

This will give you better control of your treatment schedules, more time for yourself and your family.

It will also allow you more time for your own work and activities.

Surprisingly only a small area is required.

Learn about the types of dialysis at home and discuss with your nurse or doctor.

- One-to-one training with a Home Therapy Nurse
- Learn how to manage your own access , fluid balance and dialysis machine
- Dialysis is provided
